FOR SHREWSBURY AREA PRIMARY SCHOOLS

The following service packages continue to be designed following consultation with partner schools across the Shrewsbury area. Our system works on a 4-tiered option basis, with a list of additional services if required. We are open to discuss more individualised packages on a school-to-school basis in order to meet your every need.

All packages include a 20% discount on entrance to TSA Events (already included in package costings).

FOUR-TIERED SERVICE OPTIONS 2025-2026

Platinum Package, £2300

PLATINUM

- 1. Unlimited additional events across the year
- 2. Access to Primary Summer Inset Morning
- 3. Centralised leadership academy = $\frac{1}{2}$ day delivery x3 More in-depth training of young leaders in key leadership skills, organising and running events/activities 1 per term
- 4. 1 intra school competition of your schools choosing in the calendar year (delivered on school site includes ½ day delivery training of young leaders and then organising and running an event)
- 5. 5% discount on transport on all events

Gold Package, £2000: Will have positive impact across the whole school and ensure your PE and Sport needs for the year are taken care of:

- 1. 16 TSA events across the year (school free to select individual events)
- 2. Access to Primary Summer Inset Morning
- 3. Centralised leadership academy = ½ day delivery x3 More in-depth training of young leaders in key leadership skills, organising and running events/activities 1 per term

GOLD

- 1 intra school competition of your schools choosing in the calendar year (delivered on school site includes ½ day delivery training of young leaders and then organising and running an event)
- 5. 5% discount on transport on all events

Silver Package, £1610: will have positive impact in your school and provide added value to your PE and Sport provision.

- 1. 12 TSA events across the year (School free to select individual events)
- 2. Access to Primary Summer Inset morning
- 3. Centralised leadership academy = $\frac{1}{2}$ day delivery x3 More in-depth training of young leaders in key leadership skills, organising and running events/activities 1 per term.

SILVER

Bronze package, £840: Will support your school's basic PE and Sport provision

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- 1. 8 TSA events across the year (school free to select their individual events).
- 2. Access to Primary Summer Inset morning.

Any Packages level can access any amount of add on selections from the list below (any add on will also equal a 30% discount on Getset4pe).

- 1. Additional events £100 per event
- ½ day teaching for half-term block- -£750 based on a 6-week block (could choose 3 half-terms across the year) / 1x ½ day teaching for full term block £1500
- 3. *delivery of after school provision* $\frac{1}{2}$ term = £210 / 1 term £420 / full academic year £1200
- 4. In school CPD open to all staff x1 = 200 / 1 per term 2500 / 1 per half term 2980
- Intra school competitions (on school site competition and training of young leaders to officiate/lead) = ½ day delivery x6 training, leaders, organising and running event 1 per half term £900, 1 per term (3) £450

INTER SCHOOL COMPETITIONS

You will have the opportunity to select and attend the number of events your level of SLA dictates. Events may include 'Multi Activity Days' or MAD days where a number of different sports/activities are offered on the same day. Events will take place at the most suitable venue (secondary school site, sports club/organisation site or primary school site).

INTRA SCHOOL COMPETITIONS

Do you adopt a house system in school? If not, do you provide classes/year groups with a chance to compete in a fun competition at the end of a block of work in different activity areas? If not, TSA can deliver this for your school across the year. Either by choosing 1 event p/half-term or 1 p/term, we can create a house system, train leaders to support events or provide leaders from a secondary school and add significant value to your whole school offer for PE and Sport.

'This year we wanted to give a bit more structure to our intraschool house competitions. We looked to get Gareth in to deliver training alongside the sports leaders. They have loved the sessions so far. They then deliver a skills session to a class from the school. Then we go into the competition. This hits three objectives for us: gives a wider range of children access to competition throughout the year; improves our sports leadership programme for Y6; maintains our sporting values including, teamwork and honesty throughout the year, linking in with our school values of respect, perseverance and community. 1 visit per half term works really well and the winning house gets a shout out in our celebration worship. It's a win, win and I would recommend it to any school looking to develop those two areas in the future.'

'Working with Gareth and TSA to deliver our intrahouse competitions this year has been incredibly successful so far. INSET / CPD

All CPD can be delivered in individual schools / or across a MAT/Cluster of Schools

<u>Primary Summer Inset-</u> A CPD opportunity for PE leads and deliverers of PE focussing on developing high quality PE, school sport and physical activity within the primary sector. This is a chance for teachers to review their current practice in relation to the School Games Mark and receive support with their applications prior to submission.

Individual:

CPD could be on an individual basis (e.g. supporting an ECT) or small group to develop PE delivery and understanding. We can offer a programme that supports through offering expert advice and feedback to create confident teachers.

Group CPD

This CPD is offered for inset, after-school staff meetings etc. This will provide support to teachers on developing Quality First Teaching through identifying effective pedagogical approaches to ensure progression, safe practice, engagement and inclusivity for all pupils. This programme would be best suited to using your school's curriculum plans and focusing on one or two sports per half-term/term.

LEADERSHIP TRAINING

<u>Active Starter</u> - young leaders support to lead active breaktime/lunchtimes. Will consist of ½ day training for a class of Y5 or 6 pupils on School site.

<u>Central Leadership Academy</u> - Training will consist of 1/2-day training for 4—8 Y5 or 6 pupils identified by you at a selected venue with other schools. This course equips pupils with the skills/ knowledge to plan and deliver inter-school competitions/personal challenges and train young leaders in key leadership skills. 1 per term

TEACHING/TEAM TEACHING

Teaching including team teaching, CPD opportunity or PPA cover.

<u>1/2 day teaching</u> to include delivery of high-quality PE from 9.00am—12.00pm or 12.30pm— 3.30pm to KS1 and KS2. Teaching to cover any activity within NC guidance to suit your school's needs. This can also enable team development towards competition. This could also include support/mentoring or trained Playground leaders during morning/afternoon break times.

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<u>1 day teaching</u> to include delivery of high-quality PE from 9.00am—3.30pm to KS1 and 2. Teaching to cover any activity within NC guidance to suit your school's needs. This could also include support/mentoring for trained Playground leaders

<u>1 hour afterschool club</u> (only accessible if selecting teaching and on the $\frac{1}{2}$ day/full day when teaching is agreed)
